



Baraga County Fair Color Fun Run & Walk Event Rules & Regulations

Event Coordinators: Lacey Halpin and Miriam Isaacson

Sign-Up Time: Begins 1 Hour before Event (Check Fair Schedule for Official Times).

Registration: Entry form with signed liability waiver must be submitted to the Event Coordinator on the day of the Event.

About

The Color Run will be a 2 Mile course on Papin Road in Pelkie, MI.

The average duration for a person to walk the course is about 1 hour.

This is not a timed race. The goal is to provide a fun event for participants to enjoy.

There will be multiple check points along the course where participants will be doused with colored chalk.

Parking for the event will be at the Grace Free Lutheran Church parking lot on Pelkie Road in Pelkie, MI.

Grace Free Lutheran Church has allowed participants access to their bathrooms. Use the double doors that are **not** under the carport. Please show your appreciation and be respectful of facilities.

Rules and Regulations

Appropriate athletic shoes are recommended for this event; along with unrestrictive clothing.

Participants are encouraged to wear protective eye equipment (sunglasses, eyeglasses, etc.) to avoid any possible eye-irritation from chalk dust getting into participant's eyes.

A white t-shirt is highly recommended for the best display of Fun Run colors.

Please bring water or other beverages to keep appropriately hydrated during the Color Run.

Any participant feeling faint, pain, suffering from injury, or any other form of unwell should inform race coordinators at the nearest checkpoint; or move to the shoulder of the road and motion for a race coordinator. Appropriate transport will be arranged for the participant based on the severity of the situation.

Participants under 18 years of age must have Entry Form signed by a Parent or Legal Guardian.

I, (the "Participant"), acknowledge that I have read the Rules and Regulations of the Baraga County Fair Color Fun Run & Walk ("Event"), and will abide by them. Any action that goes against those described in the Rules and Regulations is grounds for removal from the Event.

I, the Participant, releases Baraga County Fair, its affiliates, its directors, officers, employees, and agents from all liabilities assumed by Participants involvement and participation in any and all activities related to the Baraga County Fair Fun Run & Walk (the "Event"). I, the Participant, do hereby consent to participation in all actions and activities of the Event including but not limited to:

- 1. Waiver and Release: I, the Participant, of my own free will, hereby accept any and all risks of participation and waive, release and give up all claims, demands, liability, damages, costs, expenses of any kind whatsoever and I agree not to sue and agree to hold harmless the Baraga County Fair, its event sponsors, organizers, or any Baraga County Fair affiliated organization with respect to any claim that may arise in connection with my participation in this Event, whether caused by the negligence of the entities or persons mentioned in this paragraph.
- 2. Assumption of Risk: I acknowledge that my participation in this Event is voluntary, and I acknowledge that this is an athletic event and that I am in proper physical condition to participate in this Event. I understand that the Event will be run/walk over possible uneven terrain that may have unmarked hazards and that no warranty is made concerning the safety of the course. I acknowledge that at various locations on the course color powder will be thrown and potentially may get in my eyes and/or mouth. I voluntarily accept and assume responsibility for any risks and dangers that could occur during my participation in the Event and that I will comply with any and all Event directions, guidelines and rules of the Event. I understand that although most of the color powder will shake off or wash off, it may discolor my clothes and/or cloth automobile seats. I understand that I am giving up, in advance, any right to sue or make any claim against the parties I am releasing if I suffer injuries or damages, even though I do not know what or how extensive those injuries and damages might be, and am voluntarily assuming the risk of such injuries and damages.
- 3. Photographic Release: I, the Participant, grant and convey to Baraga County Fair all right, title, and interest in any and all photographs, images, video or audio recordings of the Participant or his or her likeness or voice made by Baraga County Fair in connection with the Participant's involvement in the Event, including but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds, or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.

- 4. Medical Treatment: I, the Participant, hereby Release and forever discharge Baraga County Fair from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first-aid treatment or other medical services rendered in connection with an emergency during the Participant's activity with Baraga County Fair. We give our consent for Baraga County Fair to provide, administer, or obtain medical treatment for the Participant.
- 5. Other: I, the Participant, expressly agree that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Michigan and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Michigan. I agree that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release is deemed invalid, the enforceability of the remaining provisions of this Release shall not be affected. By signing below, I, Participant, express my understanding and intent to enter into this Release and Waiver of Liability knowingly and voluntarily.

I HEREBY AFFIRM THAT I AM EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER. I HAVE READ THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENT.

FOR PERSONS UNDER EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE, A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN MUST ACCEPT THE ABOVE WAIVER AND COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING SECTION

The parent and/or legal guardian of the registered minor acknowledges that he or she has executed the foregoing waiver and release of liability for and on behalf of the named minor. I further represent that I have the legal capacity and authority to act for and on the behalf of the minor named herein, and I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless the above referenced released parties listed in the above paragraphs for any claims made of liabilities assessed against the released parties as a result of any deficiencies in my legal capacity to act for or on behalf of the minor registering for the Event.

I authorize any licensed physician or emergency personnel to treat the minor for the purpose of treating injuries received by said minor arising out of the Event. I further authorize any such physician or emergency personnel to perform all procedures deemed medically advisable in attempting to treat or relieve such injuries.
